Our whole school theme this term is 'Inventions'. Our teaching will continue to promote curiosity and risk taking. Each topic will begin with a big question. Homework

Our homework for Key Stage One continue to consist of reading regularly at home. We ask for a minimum of 4 reads a week at home. This can be their school reading book, or a book of their choice. Please note in their reading diary any reading that they have done, or encourage your child to write in their diary themselves. We request that children read their book a minimum of 2 times before changing it. This is to promote reading fluency and aid with comprehension of the text.

.This term will be using the library on a Friday and children will be able to take a book of their choice to share at home for the week. Please make sure library books are ready to be changed on a Friday. Children will only be allowed a new book once the old one is returned.

Reminders

- P.E this half term will be on a Wednesday for all of Key Stage One. Please send your child to school in their P.E uniform. Please ensure that earrings are covered, or removed before school.
- Please ensure all school uniform and belongings are named. We have a full tub of lost property in the playground.
